Library :-

The college has a separate and spacious library which is well-stacked and fast growing. The library works under supervision of the librarian Shri. Ghorpade.

1. All the students will be given library membership upto 31st August 2013. It is expected from all the students to become member of the library. Students not becoming member within given period will have to pay a fine of Rs. 25.
2. To become the member of library students should contact the librarian and secure their Borrower Ticket (B.T.)
3. All the member students will get two books (one text book & one reference book) from library. Advance learner students from every class will get two more books for study purpose.
4. Every student must return the book within 07 days from the date of issuance. Those who return the book after 07 days will be charged Rs. 1/- per day as a fine. Such students will not get another book till they return the previous one.
5. For the library related work students will have to produce their Identity card on demand.
6. For the loss of book student will be fined double the amount of the price of the book. If a student informs about loss of book after 08 days, Rs.1/- fine per day plus double of the original price will have to be paid. Student will not get library clearance certificate for such negligence.
7. Students should keep the book in good condition. If found guilty disciplinary action will be taken against such students.
8. College library accepts the text books presented by outgoing students under “Book Donation” scheme. College authority appeals the students to donate the books willingly. Also the parents and citizens too can donate their books to make the library more rich and prosperous.
9. Reading room of the library will remain open for students from 7.30 am to 6.30 pm. every day.
10. For the purpose of book transaction the students should take note of following timings :-
Junior College :- 7.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.
Senior College :- 11.00 a.m. to 5.30 p.m.
11. For suggestions, complaints and other purposes students can make use of the “Suggestion Box” kept in the library.
12. The college library runs a “Book Bank Scheme”. Under this scheme the poor and deserving students can get a set of books for the whole session. Students are advised to contact the librarian for details.
